Judgment of God 2 Corinthians 5:1-10

- I. Longing For Heavenly Home 1-5
 - a. Earthly Tent
 - i. Temporal
 - ii. Mortal
 - b. Building from God
 - i. Not made with Human hands
 - 1. No human prepared your future home but Jesus did John 14:3
 - ii. The heavenly dwelling eternal
 - 1. This is where God abides in His presence
 - c. We are longing and Groaning for our heavenly home
 - i. Groaning- to express oneself involuntarily in the face of an undesirable circumstance
 - 1. Desire deeply to our spiritual bodies
 - ii. Longing- Implication of need and desire deeply
 - iii. Clothed in our heavenly bodies Philippians 3:21 1 Corinthians 15:42-44
 - 1. What once was dishonorable is honorable, perishable imperishable
 - 2. Longing to be made glorified and perfect
 - 3. Our mortal body will add a spiritual body
- II. Courageously Walking by Faith 6-9
 - a. Be courageous walking by faith for the unforeseen future
 - i. Be certain that although we are here in body we will be with the Lord
 - b. Live by faith Not by sight
 - i. It is to live in light of ultimate rather than immediate realities

- ii. Live by the faith in the future presence of God rather than the present realities
 - 1. Paul's presence is to be with the Lord
- c. Be ambitious
 - i. Ambitious focus on rendering service and motivated to please
 - ii. You walk pleasing to the Lord
 - 1. Well done good and faithful servant Luke 19:17
- III. We will all be judged accordingly 10
 - a. Every Christian will appear before Jesus to be judged
 - i. After the rapture no one will escape judgment
 - ii. This is called the "judgment seat of Christ"
 - b. Believers will be recompensed for the things they have done in their earthly lives (while in the body).
 - Recompensed- "receive back" or "receive what is one's own" ("reap" or "get back for one's self
 - ii. Their good deeds will evoke one response (cf. 1 Cor. 4:5; Eph. 6:8)
 - 1. The rewards given by God also differ according to the work done on earth whether mastery of the old man1, enduring trials2, winning lost souls3, righteousness4, and the crown of glory5
 - iii. and the **bad** (*phaulon*, "worthless") will evoke another (1 Cor. 3:15; Col. 3:25).
 - 1. Salvation is not the issue here. One's eternal destiny will not be determined at the judgment seat of Christ. Salvation is by faith (Eph. 2:8–9),
 - 2. but deeds issuing from that faith (1 Thes. 1:3) will be evaluated.
