



S E R M O N O U T L I N E

"Together Again" 2022

The year 2022 should be a year that is focused on regathering God's people with the same determination that was exhibited in Ezra and Nehemiah as they sought to recover from their diaspora. When Israel regathered during the days of Nehemiah their focus was to rebuild the walls, but not just for the purpose of having walls (Nehemiah 1:4-11; 2:17-20).

> **TOGETHER WE SERVE** - Their focus in rebuilding the walls, while trusting the Lord to protect them against their enemies, was to better serve the rebuilding of the temple (The Book of Habakkuk and Zechariah; Ezra 6:13-18) and re-establish worship as a community of believers who were collectively working together to serve God (Ezra 10:1-17).

SERVICE AND WORSHIP - Their worship and fellowship pleased the Lord God (Nehemiah 12:27-47; Acts 2:42-47). These developments re-established Israel's relationship with the Lord.

GROWING SPIRITUALLY - When the relationship with the Lord was healthy, they were blessed, which led to the full restoration of the nation. This process created the need to refresh their commitment to the Word of God (Ezra 8; 10:).

AUTHORITY OF SCRIPTURE - God's Word caused them to worship Him sincerely, which kept the community focused on loving and supporting one another (Nehemiah 4).

CREATE COMMUNITY - Living honorable lives before God, remaining strong during adversity (Nehemiah 4), and giving as God instructed them (Nehemiah 10:28-39; 13:10-14).

TITHES - God in response to their faithful commitment in giving was motivated to refresh what was lost (Nehemiah 8).

LEADERSHIP - It took strong leadership to get them there and to hold them to the principles of God (Nehemiah 11), but in the end they were successful, and God was pleased.


