

Working Together For God's Glory

Have you ever stopped and wondered how God intended for each individual race of people to work together, especially since some races consider themselves smarter or better than others? According to John 4:1-43, Acts 10:34-35, Galatians 3:28 and Ephesians 2:11-18, every race and nationality from all of mankind is expected to do exactly that for the "Glory of God!"

How is that possible? I'm glad you asked. In order to work together for the glory of God, we must first learn to love Him no matter the circumstances we may encounter. When we submit to Him rather than succumb to cultural norms, we prove to be His disciples, not conformers to the world (Romans 12:2; John 13:34-35). All those who are tied into Christ are "one body and one Spirit, just as you also were called to one hope of your calling; one Lord, one baptism, one God and Father of all who is over all and through all and in all." (Ephesians 4:2-7). Even though we are many members, each member serves (1 Peter 4:10) to make up the one body of Christ (Colossians 1:18) so that each believer will grow to the fullness of Christ (Ephesians 4:12-16). So, whether you are Hispanic, Black, White, or Asian, if you truly love God, working together with all races brings Him Glory!

When we stand before the Lord, He is not going to separate us by our skin color, whether we think our skin color makes us smarter or better than others. This is what He said, "But when the Son of Man comes in His glory...All the nations will be gathered before Him; and He will separate them from one another, as the shepherd separates the sheep from the goats; and He will put sheep on His right, and the goats on the left. Then the King will say to those on His right, "Come, you who are blessed of My Father, inherit the kingdom prepared for you from the foundation of the world." (Matthew 25:31-34; NASU) Christ expects us to work together because we are one nation under God established by His blood on the cross. (2 Corinthians 3:18)

SERMON OUTLINE

Justice

Zechariah 7:8-14

A. The Mindset (vs. 8-10):

- 1. God is always seeking our attention; preacher after preacher, radio, TV and other media outlets, to win our hearts and lives to Himself just like He did for Israel.
- 2. This message could not be misinterpreted because it came directly to Zechariah from the Lord.
- 3. The people are described by Him as stubborn, and the Lord describes Himself as the Lord of Host; the mighty warrior. (1 Peter 5:5; Proverbs 13:13).
- 4. The Lord of host commands them to organize an administrative process that delivers the people from oppression so that they live in peace. God is holy and therefore just.
- 5. They were commanded to litigate every decision based on the Word of God. This was not to be out of political biases or personal convictions.
- 6. They have an ethical obligation to obey the commands of the Lord of host and to remain steadfastly loyal to each other by generously maintaining each other's rights.
- 7. Generously love each other with sensitivity being given to each other's needs.
- 8. They must continuously not defraud, extort, or exploit the widows or the orphans, the stranger, or the poor.
- 9. By stating "evil in your heart", the Lord is saying that they must not create in themselves the mind or will to live in violation of God's standards as they relate to each other (Amos 5:14-15).

B. Must Listen (v. 11):

- 1. The people of Israel continuously rejected what the Lord of host said, refusing to obey the will of God.
- 2. Their body language was continuously decisively demonstrating their lack of interest.
- 3. They purposefully put it in their minds to force themselves to completely not even try to come to an understanding of what's being said.
- 4. Flint implies that their hearts became impenetrable due to its extreme hardness.
- 5. Because their hearts were impenetrable, they had no desire to be instructed about the Word.
- 6. They need to listen because He's "got the power".
- 7. The Lord's love for them causes Him to try harder by sending Spirit led prophets.
- 8. The Lord became continuously angry because of their unwillingness to submit to His will.

C. The Avenger (v. 12):

- 1. They were totally committed to not provide their undivided attention to the Lord.
- 2. Israel continuously, loudly sought to get the Lord of host attention.
- 3. The Lord of host had determined to endlessly not listen to Israel.
- 4. The mighty holy warrior who reigns was completely committed to not listen to their prayers (John 15:1-11).
- 5. The Lord of host punished Israel by scattering them.
- 6. It is Israel's stubborn attitude that caused their desolation.
