
Pastaral REFLECTIONS August 21, 2022 Activate the Holy Spirit

There is no question that in a church or in a home we may experience emotional pain because of what someone may say or do. Our response can either be one of restoration or we can focus on destroying the person who hurt us. One response can activate the ministry of the Holy Spirit who is stimulated as a result of our commitment to the Word (Ephesians 4:17-24) or we can respond naturally which is led by the flesh (Galatians 5:16-21). To be led by the flesh allows satan to get a foothold, which stimulates more destruction (Ephesians 4:26-27).



When our emotional pain leads us to function in the flesh, we may never destroy the other person more than we destroy ourselves (Matthew 6:14-15). Emotional pain is harder to heal than physical pain, and this is why God has given the church the gifts of encouragement and mercy. This is why the ministry of the Holy Spirit is to comfort us and be our peace (John 14:16,18,27; 16:7). Let's intentionally allow our relationship with Christ to regenerate the needed strength and insight we need to direct our relationship with others (1 John 2:3-6, 9-11; 4:7-13).



I. Look Up vs. 11-12

- A. Take charge in the midst of disruption
 - 1. Be bold 1 Tim. 1:7
 - 2. Be disciplined 1 Tim. 1:7
 - 3. Be humble 2 Tim. 2:25
- B. Don't give anyone a reason to discount you 2 Tim. 2:22/ Ecc. 9:11
 - 1. Leverage your perspective and your circumstances for heavenly gain
 - —Leadership is based on spiritual development, not age
 - 2. Remember your spiritual responsibilities 1 Thess. 5:22
- C. Reflect on Christ, reflect on greatness:
 - 1. In what you say Eph. 4:29
 - —Speech is a revealer of character and heart posture
 - —Holy Spirit's influence and purifying of the heart produces godly speech
 - 2. In how you conduct yourself Col. 1:10
 - 3. By loving God and your neighbor as yourself 1 Cor. 13
 - 4. Keep faith in adversity Gal. 6:9
 - —Be confident in Christ and what He has done
 - —Build your life on the truth of His word
 - 5. Preserving your purity 1 Cor. 6:19
 - —Your body and mind are sacred;, honor God with them
 - —Impurity destroys our reputation, influence and fellowship with God

II. Deliverance Through Perseverance vs. 15-16

- A. Persistence in self-examination saves you from destruction
 - 1. Watch your heart and doctrine closely Prov. 4:23
 - 2. Hold yourself accountable and invite others to as well Jam. 5:16
 - 3. Intentionally and consistently invest in your walk
 - 4. The disciplined will be preserved through danger
