I. God's Plan (v. 6-14)

1. In our crisis we must consider:
 - a. God's character ^{v.3}
 - b. God's purpose ^{v. 4, 11 & 15}
 - c. God's timing ^{v.6}

2. His plan will always accomplish two things: ^{v.15}
 - a. He will always meet our needs
 - b. Bring God Glory

II. Christ Presence Brings Change (v.21-36)

1. The sisters had faith in Jesus' sovereignty ^{v.21-27}
 - a. Mary and Martha in pain and did not understand Christ's delay
 - b. Mary and Martha's pain didn't stifle their belief
 - c. Mary and Martha knew Christ had all authority
 - d. Mary and Martha Possessed an eternal perspective
 - e. God is the only resurrector of body and spirit

2. Christ is sensitive to the pain of the sisters ^{v.33-36}
 - a. Jesus did not distance himself those who were hurting
 - b. Christ love is demonstrated through action

III. Risen Perspective (v.40-46)

1. Faith grants us intimacy with God ^{v.40-42}
 - a. Our faith allows us to access the depth of God
 - b. Christ reveals himself as divine
 - c. Faith will be strengthened

2. The power of Christ should be on display in our lives ^{v.45}
 - a. Christ uses the faithful to fulfill His purpose
