I. The Lord deserves praise in every season of life

1. We worship a great and unchanging God
 - a. God deserves praise for who He is
 - b. Praise for what He has done
2. Blessing the Lord is a deeply personal expression of appreciation and gratitude
 - a. Sincere praise and worship have no age barrier
 - b. God's greatness is unfathomable

II. Changing circumstances can be a cause of concern or consistent praise for generations Psalm 71:5-6

1. Praise and worship shift our attention to the object of our hope, The Lord
 - a. The Lord is not your distraction from distress, He is your delight in the distress
 - We signify something about God with our lives when we are in distress

b. Meditation and proper application of His word reshapes our attitudes, thoughts, feelings, expressions **Rom. 12:1-2 Eph. 4:22-23.**

2. The traits of a great worshiper:

a. Consistency, humility and dependency

3. Worship and gratitude make a believer resilient to Satan's schemes
