On a farm, there was a pond and a little brook. It was in the rainy season, and both were full to the brim with clean, pure water. It is in the dry season, and the difference in their natures shows up. The stream, constantly flowing to water the banks all along its course, still keeps pure and sparkling; it continues to draw from the underground springs at its source and to give freely as it goes along. The pond, neither receiving nor giving, hoards its precious moisture only to have its waters become foul and stagnant. "Honor the Lord from your wealth and from the first of all your produce; so your barns will be filled with plenty and your vats will overflow with new wine." (Proverbs 3:9-10).

Many years ago, a lad, 16 years old, was obliged to leave home because his father was too poor to support him. So, he trudged away with all worldly possessions in a bundle dangling from his hand, resolving as he journeyed to set up a business as a soap maker in New York. When the country boy arrived in the big city, he found it hard to get work. Remembering his mother's last words and the godly advice given him by the captain of a canal boat, the youth dedicated his life to God, determined to return to his Maker an honest tithe of every dollar he earned. So, when his first dollar came in, the young man sacredly dedicated ten cents to the Lord. This he continued to do. And the dollars rolled in! Soon, this young man became a partner in a soap business, and when his partner died a few years later, he became the sole owner of the concern. The prosperous businessman now instructed his bookkeeper to open an account with the Lord and credit it one-tenth of all his income. The business grew miraculously. The honest proprietor now dedicated two-tenths of his earnings, and then three-tenths, four-tenths, and finally, five-tenths. His sales increased proportionately to his generosity, so soon, his soap brand became a household word worldwide. SERMON OUTLINE

Invest Luke 6:38

A. Guaranteed Returns (v. 38a):

- 1. Christ commands us to decisively (as He gives to us; 1 Corinthians 16:1-2) make it a habit to repeatedly put in place what He has commanded us to do with a cheerful heart (2 Corinthians 9:6-15).
- Giving is viewed as the 'harvest of righteousness' (fruit of the Spirit; 2 Corinthians 9:10) because our commitment to obey God's Word repeatedly, demonstrates acts of faith showing that we trust Him to fulfill His Word.
- 3. Even though God demonstrates many acts of love towards us every day; when we choose to give He permanently provides back to us what we have given Him. In other words we add a level of security to what we had in the first place as He gives it back to us.

B. High Percentage Yield (v. 38b)

- 1. The Lord's promise is with no mind to be exact with us because of our obedience to Him. It is His grace to us. Grace is spontaneous, generous, and free-hearted with no expectation of return to the giver.
- 2. What God permanently put back in place is something we now possess. It is designated as belonging to us and no one else. Bosom or lap means a person's personal space.
- 3. Good measure is the execution of God's gift, based on the will of God, precisely as it should be implemented so it is done with fairness and without error. God is good (James 1:17), so there is no way He can rob anyone. We are the ones that rob Him (Malachi 3:8).
- 4. The Lord would do whatever it takes to provide for us beyond our measure. God may allow some pressure to come upon our lives to finish school; and excel at our jobs so that He can find ways to bless us beyond our expectations; for example, "Poor is he who works with a negligent hand, but the hand of the diligent makes rich." (Proverbs 10:4)
- 5. To people who are farmers shaking out barley, Christ uses what they are accustomed to doing as they seek to get all they can from their harvest. Christ will ensure that what He provides back to us is missing absolutely nothing when it is returned to our permanent possession.
- 6. God's return is not just completely everything we gave to Him; it, is continuously delivered beyond the measure we gave. Just as we make it a habit to repeatedly give to God, God repeatedly makes it a habit to be excessive in His response to us.
- 7. Running over-emphasizes God's generosity. He does not mind if our "barns will be filled with plenty and your vats will overflow with new wine." (Proverbs 3:10).

B. The Returns Depends on What is Invested (v. 38c):

- All of what the Lord is going to do is continuously determined by how we give. God is waiting on us, while many people are waiting on God.
- 2. The Lord who cannot lie (Hebrews 6:18) promises to repay us; in the manner described in this passage, precisely as He said He will. This is His promise to us.
- 3. If a pastor or church were to do wrong to anyone, it would not stop what God promises and says He will do to those who abuse His sheep (Ezekiel 34:7-10).
